**Peter Broadbent** is the founding conductor of the Joyful Company of Singers, Director of Training for *abcd* and a widely experienced choral clinician and adjudicator. Peter has conducted the London Mozart Players, the City of London Sinfonia, the BBC Singers and many other ensembles, broadcasting frequently on BBC Radio 3 and Classic FM. In 2007 he was awarded the "Pro Cultura Hungarica" Prize by the Ministry of Education and Culture of the Republic of Hungary for his contribution

to strengthening Anglo-Hungarian cultural relations.



**Neil Ferris** is the Artistic Director and Conductor of the new professional chamber choir Sonoro. He is also Music Director of Wimbledon Choral Society, Associate Chorus Director of the London Symphony Chorus, Chorus Director at the Royal College of Music and Chorus Master at the Endellion Summer Festival. He is also Guest Conductor of Manchester Chamber Choir and Birmingham Bach Choir. Until 2015 he was Head of **Evoke** is a fresh new chamber ensemble on the London scene with a versatile approach to choral music. Founder and conductor, Victoria Ely, is currently MD for Milton Keynes Chorale, Conductor/Producer for Voces Academy and is increasingly in demand as a workshop leader at festivals across the UK and Europe. Victoria graduated from the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama with Distinction in 2014 where she studied with Neil Ferris, Sarah Tenant-Flowers and Simon Halsey.
