

# Extended Conducting Courses Initial Level London 2015

**abcd**'s choral conducting courses are designed to develop the individual. Experienced tutors work with your natural abilities and previous experience to enable you to develop your own gesture vocabulary and rehearsal technique. As the training is non prescriptive in approach, with an emphasis on a supportive and encouraging environment, it will develop confidence and practical skills which can be used by those leading singing of any kind, regardless of age group, music genre or experience of singers.

The courses consist of several sessions over an extended period, and include plenary sessions on vocal and rehearsal techniques and masterclasses. Video footage is provided to support individual study and development between sessions. A small group size is guaranteed (maximum 17 participants) to allow focus and ample practical time.

While every course will take you on an individual journey, by working with those at a similar stage of development you will increase the opportunities to share and learn from each other.



Jo McNally is a music educator from the USA who has been living in the UK since 1980 working as an animateur, conductor, and singer. Her current choirs include Farnham Girls Training Choir and Wokingham Choral Academy. As an animateur she has worked on special projects for the Education departments of ENO/Bayliss, Royal Opera House, Glyndbourne and the BBC Singers. She has been on the team developing and delivering *abcd* conducting courses since their inception.

**Katie Thomas** is the Director of Brighton Consort and undertakes freelance conducting engagements for her own professional ensembles. She trained in Choral Conducting at the Royal Academy of Music and graduated with Distinction. Katie is Consultant Artistic Director for the "Music of the Golden Age Festival" based in Hampshire. As a tutor, she works with the National Youth Choir of Great Britain, the National Youth Choir of Wales and the Association of British Choral Directors.

Initial Course This consists of four one-day sessions spread over 4 months. It is both suitable for those with no previous training, who are not yet conducting regularly and those who have some experience leading choral music. It is also suitable for those want to develop and/or consolidate their conducting and vocal technique. Many who take this course are musicians who have not conducted choirs before, assistant conductors with no previous training, teachers who have been asked to lead a choir and those who find themselves conducting unexpectedly.

#### **Initial content**

- Preparation
- Voice training the conductor as singer
- Developing simple conducting gestures
- Learning to communicate with gesture instead of words
- Developing awareness of vocal technique
- Using warm-up exercises to develop your choir
- Score preparation for rehearsal and performance
- How to communicate with your choir and lead efficient and enjoyable rehearsals
- Guidance on choosing suitable repertoire
- Development of programme-planning skills
- As the course develops, there may also be opportunities to cover the following:
- Further development of conducting gesture
- Working with more challenging repertoire
- Development of programme-planning skills

**Course cost:** The price for all four sessions is £265 (£235 *abcd* members).
