He is also Director of the Liverpool Welsh Choral Union and was Chorus Master of the Hallé Choir for seven years, also acting as guest conductor for other symphony choruses in the UK, including the BBC Symphony Chorus during this time. He founded the Beaumaris Singers of Newport in the 1980's and directed them until 2004, and more recently has worked as Director of Music at Liverpool's Metropolitan Cathedral.

He has also led vouth and children's choirs and mixed adult choirs such as the Birmingham Singers. Stone Choral Society and the Staffordshire Youth Choir and is frequently invited to lead choral workshops for ABCD and at the Hereford International Summer School.

In 2006 Keith was appointed s Vocal Projects Leader for Wigan Borough.


