Training

abcd's choral conducting courses are designed to develop the individual. Experienced tutors work with your natural abilities and previous experience to enable you to develop your own gesture vocabulary and rehearsal technique. Training takes place in a supportive and encouraging environment. This individually tailored approach develops confidence and practical skills which can be used by those leading singing of any kind.

Extended Conducting Courses run over several months and are taught at Foundation, Initial and Intermediate Level. There is a Young Conductors programme for those aged 18-25 years. We also offer specialist days on subjects of interest to choir leaders such as orchestral conducting with choirs and vocal health.

Annual Convention

This is the highlight of the *abcd* calendar and a unique opportunity to meet leading composers, conductors and vocal experts. Sessions cover everything from starting a community choir to the latest thinking in voice production. Top international choirs share their expertise in open rehearsals and take part in our spectacular gala concert. An extensive trade exhibition is open throughout the weekend attended by all the main suppliers to the British choral industry including publishers, tour operators and agents covering every possible type of singing group from a small children's choir to a gospel group, cathedral choir or choral society.
